- B Bars/restaurants near gates
- C Easy access to outside
- D Glass room -or- outside is within 200 yards of gates -or- bars/restaurants far from gates
- E No smoking inside; outside is far from gates

- A Dallas Love Field (served only by Southwest Airline)
- B Albuquerque - restaurants
- B Boston (Logan) - bars, easy access to outside
- B Charlotte
- B Charleston WV - indoor smoking lounge very close to gate areas with a great view of the runway traffic
- B Cincinnati - smoking in a couple of bars
- B Cleveland
- B Columbus OH - back room of restaurant on 2nd level, no purchase required
- B Dayton OH - smoking in a couple of snack bars

- B Fairbanks - Smoking in cocktail lounge only, near security gate
- B Fort Lauderdale - bars, small terminal
- B Lubbock TX - restaurant, small terminal
- B Moline IL - smoking in coffee shop not far from gates; easy access to outside; waiting lobbies outside security but convenient
- B New York (JFK)
- B New York (LaGuardia)
- B Norfolk, VA - glass rooms near gates
- B Ontario - bars
- B Orange County CA (John Wayne)
- B Philadelphia - restaurants
- B Phoenix - some bars (hard to find)
- B Pittsburgh
- B Richmond, VA - designated smoking areas near gates

- B Washington (National) - some bars (hard to find)
- C Dallas (DFW) - easy access to outside
- C Los Angeles (LAX) - easy access to outside balconies
- C Worcester, MA - no smoking inside terminal
- D Atlanta (Hartsfield) - glass room

- D Denver (new airport) - bar, \$2 coffee
- D El Paso - cute outside patio, take a right at bottom of escalator
- D Islip NY - small terminal, no smoking inside
- D Las Vegas - glass room
- D New Orleans - restaurants far from gates
