On October 4, 1973, Mario Andretti drove this Viceroy Special to a new world's closed course speed record - 214.158 m.p.h. - at the Texas World Speedway, Bryan, Texas.

The Viceroy Special was created for the Vel's-Parnelli Jones Racing Team by the world-famous race car designer, Maurice Phillippe. With the Viceroy Special, Phillippe added lustre to a career that has produced cars that won the world's Formula One Grand Prix championship and twice won the USAC National Championship.
